

**Painting – Surrealists DREAMS AND NIGHTMARES**

CURRICULUM CONTENT SKILLS

<p><b>KNOW</b> Surrealism is a 20th-century avant-garde movement in art and literature which sought to release the creative potential of the unconscious mind, for example by the irrational juxtaposition of images. (Wiki)</p>
<p><b>UNDERSTAND</b> Develop and Refine artistic skills in a variety of styles and movements. Express meaning, intent and emotion through visual art.</p>
<p><b>CREATE</b> Inspired by the surrealist movement and their use of dreams to create paintings that are simultaneously realistic and non-representational, we will create a painting that is depicting a dream (or dream-like mood) using symbolism, juxtaposition and mood.</p>

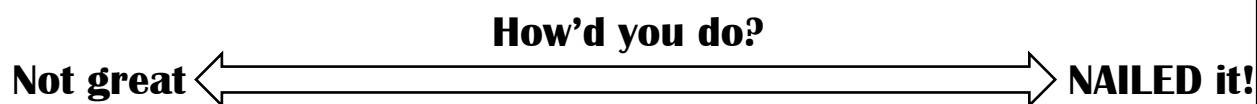
