Assessment – Due Dates, Marking and Grades

Due Dates

We will have new project introductions on Mondays, classroom sharing discussions on Tuesdays to get ideas flowing and several small group, peer and self reflection times over several days to keep on task and focussed on the current projects. I will conduct formative assessments while you're working so you know what you're doing well and what you could strengthen. "Due Dates" will be Fridays after a unit is introduced. At the end of a unit we will have a 1 on 1 chat to decide upon a final mark for the unit based on all the work you've done over the last 1 to 2 weeks. If you are unhappy with your score you can work on your projects in your own time, at lunch and during tutorial to be re-assessed.

Marking Criteria

How will we "decide on a mark" if every student is making individualized projects and so many courses run in one class? I will try to have clear expectations for each project you are working on written on the board. We will conduct multiple peer critiques during work time so you can keep each other accountable. You will start each project with a goal of an idea, technique or skill you'd like to challenge yourself with. At the end we will re-visit these goals and see how you did.

Grades, Reporting and Contact

Your grades will be updated at the end of each unit. You can ask me what your grades are currently at in between those times, or just wait until the 1 on 1 chats to see. I will send home reports through email after each unit so your families can be in the know.

I strongly encourage you to ask questions when you have them, come in at lunch or tutorial to keep working on your projects or to ask for extra 1 on 1 help. I have high expectations for this crowd but I will make sure to be available to help achieve your goals.
