Curriculum – Big Ideas, Units, Lessons

Big Ideas

Creative arts experiences can build community and nurture relationships with others

Art has the ability to say words, feelings or stories we don't yet want or know how to say. In this class you will learn how to use art to describe stories, your individual perspective, your likes and dislikes. We we work with each other to peer critique which means we will learn how to help build each other up and make our community feel like successful artists.

UNITS: Each unit will focus on a source of inspiration, a material and a technique and a project.

We will learn to draw detailed pieces with correct perspective like Da Vinci would have done during the renaissance.	We will be inspired by the "plein air" trend of the impressionists to create landscapes that display the wonder of the world we live in.	We will practice hand building clay techniques to create a garden gnome, or tea pot.	We will use plaster and paper mache in order to create a mask or a caste of a hand.	We will practice proper camera use and introduce ourselves to digital drawing tablets to create a digital painting or photo manipulation.

Lessons and Materials

Each unit will be centered around an artistic intention, wither it's from history or contemporary art, and a corresponding material to go with it. We will conduct research before each project for proper inspiration. All needed materials will be provided, but you can bring any materials you have at home to use in class. (Talk to me for good brands/deals and short term storage.)

We will have new project introductions on Mondays, classroom sharing discussions on Tuesdays to get ideas flowing and several small group, peer and self reflection times over several days to keep on task and focussed on the current projects. I will conduct formative assessments while you're working so you know what you're doing well and what you could strengthen. "Due Dates" will be Fridays after a unit is introduced. At the end of a unit we will have a 1 on 1 chat to decide upon a final mark for the unit based on all the work you've done over the last 1 to 2 weeks. If you are unhappy with your score you can work on your projects in your own time, at lunch and during tutorial to be re-assessed.

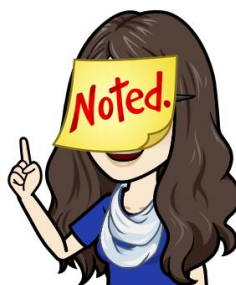
Marking Criteria

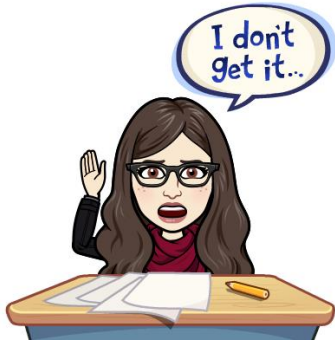
Grades, Reporting and Contact
